after it was requested. The Model 1892 was intended as an update of the the Winchester Model 1873-also designed by Browning-which it replaced as the company's pistol-caliber lever gun. Over its 50-year production life more than 1,000,000 Model 1992s were produced, and it

starred in nearly every cowboy Western ever made, including the TV series The Rifleman and "Wanted: Dead or Alive."

The Rossi R92 is available chambered in .22 LR, .357 Mag., .44 Rem. Mag., .45 Long Colt and .454 Casull, in a variety finishes, with a variety of furniture

and in a number of different barrel lengths. Our evaluation rifle was the unique R92 Triple Black chambered in .44 Rem. Magnum (also available in .357 Magnum) with a 16.5-inch barrel (\$1,020.11). Everything on the gun—except the

brass bead front sight—is finished in a weatherproof matte black, giving it an "all business" look. All metal parts are coated with a black Cerakote finish for excellent durability in crappy weather conditions.

Other features include a "big loop" lever with its lower half wrapped in black synthetic cordage. The big loop lever — made popular years ago by the lever-action specialists of Wild West Guns — is hugely advantageous when large- or gloved-hands are thrown into the mix and is definitely a welcomed addition. A unique sighting arrangement — including a barrel mounted 12-slot aluminum Picatinny rail for optics mounting with an integral and fully adjustable,

sor or muzzle brake. Furniture consists of a matte black buttstock with flat-topped comb and 1-inch, ventilated, black-rubber recoil pad, and a one-piece forearm with single barrel band. Both buttstock and forend are made from wood, both

ramp-mounted peep sight positioned at the rear — are a clever and effective workaround to the model 1892's top-eject receiver design. Although we didn't add either for testing, the muzzle of this R92 comes threaded from the factory (with an included thread protector) for quick installation of a suppresare fitted with sling swivel studs and both are finished in a black, spiderweb-like, splatter paint surface finish for all-weather protection.

In a departure from the original 1892 design, the R92 incorporates a Rossi-designed rotating safety

With an empty weight of 5 lbs. 14 oz., and an overall length of 34 inches, the R92 Triple Black .44 Rem. Mag. is a lightweight and handy carbine for brush-gun duty.

Its .44 Rem Mag. chambering lends itself to medium game hunting at short to moderate ranges. We've killed

line — the distance we like to test rifles at when magnification isn't part of the equation — we broke out the three different .44 Magnum loads we could get our hands on for testing: Black Hills nasty-little 160-grain HoneyBad-

ger, SIG's premium 240-grain Elite V-Crown JHP and Federal's 280-grain Swift A-Frame loads. In the downrange-precision department, the Black Hills, SIG and Federal loads all laid down stellar performance through the R92's launch tube, all printing a best three-shot group of under

# SAVAGE IMPULSE PREDATOR

# FINALLY. AN AFFORDABLE STRAIGHT-PULL

AVAGE ARMS HAS NOT BEEN  $\mathbf{J}$  shy about betting on new rifle technology in recent years, and now the company is rolling the dice on something most American shooters have never embraced – a straightpull bolt action rifle.

Straight-pull rifles have long been popular in Europe, but those guns typically cost far more than most American hunters are willing to pay. Now they don't have to thanks to the Savage Impulse, the first made-in-America straight-pull bolt action rifle.

I recently tested the Savage Impulse Predator model chambered in 6.5 Creedmoor (it's also available in 22-250 Rem., 243 Win and 308 Win.) and came away impressed with the accuracy and operation of this gun. It is, in a word, fast – and that's a good thing when you have multiple predators inbound on the run.

The Savage design employs a HexLock bolt that uses six stainless steel ball bearings and a detent in the receiver to lock up. Push the bolt forward to close the action and the bolt handle rotates forward, engaging a mechanism that expands the ring of

bearings and locks the action. Pulling the trigger unlocks the bolt, as does a button on the rear of the bolt. When you pull the bolt back, the handle rotates back to its rearward position as a case is extracted. The bolt cycles smoothly, but you need to draw it back with just a little authority to fully eject cases. Once you get used to it, you can run the gun with blazing speed compared to traditional

bolt action rifles. The rifle can be highly customized to fit vour individual

needs. Its ambidextrous design allows you to easily swap the bolt handle from side to side, and you can even adjust the angle of the bolt handle. The AccuFit stock, which sports a Mossy Oak Terra Gila camo finish and a substantial recoil pad, comes with spacers and risers that let you adjust length of pull and comb height.

Much of the rifle's 8.7-pound weight is attributable to a beefy, medium-contour 20-inch carbon- steel barrel that's mated to an aluminum receiver and threaded to accept brakes or suppressors.

The action is bedded to the stock via the Savage AccuStock system, which uses an aluminum rail to engage the action three-dimensionally along its entire length.

One thing you won't lack with the Impulse Predator is firepower. It's equipped with a detachable 10-round AICS magazine with an ambidextrous release. The spring-loaded, hinged magazine release positioned at the front of the trigger guard takes a bit of pressure

to operate, making it unlikely that a magazine could be accidentally dropped from the receiver.

The rifle is equipped with the much-copied, clean-breaking Savage AccuTrigger, which is user-adjustable down to a pull weight of about 3 lbs. Our test gun arrived

from the factory with a trigger pull weight of 3 lbs., 6 oz.

Savage rifles have long had a reputation for shooting accurately out of the box, so I was keen to see how the Predator performed at the range. With a Leupold Mark 3HD 4-12x40 scope mounted to

the one-piece, 20-MOA rail machined into the top of the receiver, I put the gun through its paces with

6.5 Creedmoor ammo from Black Hills, Hornady and Winchester in a variety of bullet weights.

The rifle did not disappoint. Three of four tested loads produced sub-MOA average 100-yard groups of 0.69, 0.83 and 0.88 inches, and the gun delivered best

groups measuring less than half an inch with Hornady's Precision Hunter 143 gr. ELD-X load and Winchester's 140 gr. BTHP match ammo. The worst-performing load, with a lighter, 95 gr. varmint bullet, still turned in average groups measuring just 1.16 inches, which will definitively get the job done. Measured bullet velocities were, on average, 190 fps slower than factory-stated numbers, but that's to be expected with the gun's relatively short 20-inch barrel. system isn't new, having been proven in use by some European gun makers. What is new is the affordability of a straight-pull system in this American-made rifle, which is priced far below European straightpull guns with a MSRP of \$1,379. # THE AR-15-ish BOLT ACTION

IG has done an admirable job at **J** pulling major talent out of the firearms industry and bringing it all under one roof. It then consolidates this talent into all-star teams, mostly made up of engineers, product managers and segment experts, who are then assigned (or let loose) to tackle specific projects. The rifle you see here, like many other SIG initiatives, is a product of this winning strategy.

Meet SIG's new-for-2020 bolt-action rifle, appropriately named the Cross—short for crossover. This general purpose, do-it-all rifle bridges the gap between lightweight hunting and long-range precision chassis rifles, and is fully capable of undertaking any task in-between. Tipping the scales at just 6.5 pounds, and folding to a length of just 25 inches, this sub-half-MOA capable rifle provides a package unmatched in today's market—especially at an MSRP of \$1649.99 to \$1,879.99, depending on finish.

The Cross is initially being made available in three calibers: 6.5 Creedmoor, .308 Win, and the all-new .277 SIG Fury. The latter is based on a U.S. Army requirement for a new 6.8mm cartridge. The .277 SIG Fury is the commercialized version of that round, and opens the doors to both civilian precision shooting and hunting markets; each segment

will reap the advantages of the research and development that were poured into the creation of the cartridge. Once ammunition comes online, you'll have a 135-grain laser beam traveling in excess of 3,000 feet per second, out of a 16-inch barrel, from a platform that weights 6.5 pounds. It sounds a little scary, but perceived recoil is less than a .308 Win. fired from the same gun, and performance is astounding.

The .277 SIG Fury is slated for a somewhat delayed release, as ammunition production ramps up. Until then, you can get your hands on either the 16-inch .308 Win., or the 18-inch 6.5 Creedmoor, both of which have been shipping for quite some time now. Our test gun was chambered in .308 Win. and outfitted with a 16-inch, cold-hammer forged, 5R rifled barrel, finished in an attractive bead blasted grey color. The gun proved to be wicked accurate and damned handy.

If the platforms like the P320 and MCX are any indication, it should come as no surprise that the Cross was designed from the ground up to be modular and easily upgradeable. The action of the Cross is unique and not based upon anything else currently available. It most closely resembles an AR-15, which allowed SIG to greatly reduce the weight of the rifle, while at the same time

paving the way for upgrades. The bolt, as an example, floats similarly to that of an AR-15, which is a clue that more calibers are to come. The barrel, barrel nut and forward portion of the receiver also closely resemble an AR-15, as do the safety selector and pistol grip. See a pattern developing? These are all important pieces of engineering, as they greatly expand the possibilities of the Cross, opening it up to easy barrel changes, handguard swaps and other upgrades, all of which are on the way.

The massive, three-lug bolt feeds the rifle from a center-fed, AICS-pattern magazine. A massive bladed extractor and properly placed ejector produce reliable, repeatable case extraction that tosses spent cases low enough to avoid contact with optic windage turrets. Bolt A LONG, SLIM AND STABLE M-LOK COMPATIBLE FOREND PRO-VIDES NEEDED VERSATILITY WHILE HELPING TO KEEP OVERALL WEIGHT IN CHECK. throw is extremely short and intuitive, and combined with a near perfectly placed, ergonomic bolt handle, you've got a platform that can be accurately fired at a surprisingly rapid pace.

To date, we've logged just shy of 850 rounds through this particular rifle. Tens of 5-shot groups have punched paper at ranges from 100 to 500 yards off the bipod, tripod and bench. Steel has been hammered from 600 to 1,000 yards, quite effortlessly. Our test Cross loaded with Hornady 168-grain ELD-Match ammunition printed a .40-inch group at 100 yards, and a .60-inch group with Black Hills' 178-grain ELD-X hunting load—three of which were in a .30-inch cluster.

The Cross has proven to be a lightweight, fully adjustable and incredibly accurate platform. The long handguard allows plenty of surface area to get stable in field-expedient shooting po-

sitions, and there's plenty of space to add a bipod or ARCA rail for use with a tripod. Once the fully adjustable stock was properly tuned, the entire package just felt right in hand. We really appreciated the skinny handguard and more vertical pistol grip, making it easy to grasp and pull in tight within the shoulder pocket and stabilize it—making long off-hand shots suddenly easy. T'S NOT EASY BECOMING AN OLD FART. It takes a lifetime to accomplish, but one day you just wake up and realize you've arrived. It is with deep regret that I acknowledge the day has arrived for me.

You'll know you're there when all of a sudden nothing you took for

granted as a normal part of life when you were a kid exists any longer. The milk man, the bread delivery guy, the bakery man, TVs with antennas, gigantic American cars with white-wall tires, corded telephones

and bolt-action rifles with high-polish blued metal and highly figured French walnut stocks. It's the last item, of course,

which prompted this lament, as I just received my 500th synthetic-stocked bolt-action rifle with matte black metal finish to review. Hey, I may be an old fart, but I'm not stupid. I understand that this is what hunters want these days. Every rifle manufacturer offers them — usually in multiple lines — and they're inexpensive and easy to clean

and care for. And they're getting better, less expensive and more feature rich every day. Perfect example: the new Patriot Long Range Hunter from Mossberg.

This new member of the "plastic rifle" genre offers very innovative features most hunters care about. Being the Long-range variant of the Patriot line, it's chambered in one

very popular short-action caliber (.308 Win.) and three go-fast cartridges:

.300 Win Mag., 6.5 Creedmoor (tested) and the new red-hot 6.5 PRC. All models of the Patriot Long Range Hunter are priced at \$766. Other Patriot models start at \$421, and Vortex-scoped combos start at \$570. The Patriot Long Range Hunter lacks the adjustable-comb stock, 10-round magazine and bull barrel of its big brother, the Mossberg MVP LR Long Range, but it's lighter, comes in a wider range of calibers and has no shortage of features that

medium-sporter with a matte black, phosphate-like finish. hanced grip. Molded-in checkering is completely absent, and to be honest, wasn't really missed.

In keeping with this rifle's longrange role, we mounted a Bushnell Banner 2 6-18x50 riflescope on the Picatinny top rail. While getting the rifle dialed in at 100-yards for bench testing, we noted that the bolt was both smooth and quick, aided by the enlarged bolt handle no doubt. We've always been able to wring out great downrange precision from the Patriot rifles we've tested over the years and the Long Range Hunter certainly didn't put a stain on this record. Using Federal's 130-grain Terminal Ascent load, we were able to drill a best-of-testing 0.64-inch three-shot group. All other ammo gave us sub-

MOA performance, and the Black Hills 143-grain Hornady ELD-X load was nipping at the heels of the winner with a 0.69-inch group. Overall, a very good showing.

Nothing we tested fell outside Springfield's 0.75 MOA guarantee, and most groups were under 0.70 inches. Group testing was performed using the muzzle brake, with the addition of a Dead

Air Silencers Nomad-30 suppressor.

Balance was excellent with or without the suppressor. There was no perceptible impact shift from barrel heating on 10 round strings at 300 yards with the BSF barrel.

The Waypoint 2020 fit nicely in my Eberlestock X1A3 pack, was comfortable to carry, and set up on my tripod quickly. Blast at the shooter is minimal using the supplied brake; it's loud, but there is a noticeable reduction in

felt recoil. Suppressed, it remained easy to shoot, well balanced and plenty quiet for hunting without hearing protection.

Bolt operation is smooth and tight with zero wobble and zero binding with just the right amount of lift

pressure and a bolt knob that was easy to grab onto. Ejection was consistent no matter how hard we ran the bolt, and there were no issues feeding from four different AICS magazines, including a double stack Accurate-Mag. The stock is very solid, and it feels handmade-no fantastic plastic here. Overall, the Waypoint 2020 feels very much like a custom-built precision rifle.

This rifle has many features you

expect to see on rifles at twice the price—namely the carbon stock, carbon wrapped barrel, fluted bolt, stainless steel action—all built to very tight tolerances. Accuracy is excellent and you're left feeling like you bought a \$5,000. custom precision rifle for \$2,399 (the actual cost of our test configuration). I liked the 2020 Waypoint enough to order one in 6.5PRC for myself. If you want an out-of-the-box precision rifle for hunting, duty work or just plain fun on the range, look no further than this one. groove technology. Grooves improve accuracy while reducing fouling and barrel wear but, according to Federal engineers, they also result in about a five percent drop in BC per groove. The engineers found they could achieve the same benefits and accuracy with one or two strategically placed grooves versus the three grooves used in older bullet designs. They

also used computational fluid dynamic modeling to alter the grooves to reduce drag. While most grooves have 90-degree walls, AccuChannel grooves have a sloped rear wall that reduces pressure and drag on the bullet.

in North America that can't be taken with a 280 Ackley Improved and Terminal Ascent ammo.

Velocity for that load was clocked at 2,887 fps, which is only 43 fps slower than the factory-stated velocity for that round of 2,930 fps. Mind you, that's out a new barrel that hasn't been fully broken in yet, so I would expect a slight velocity gain over time.

# The Midwestern Sledgehammer

**IKE MANY YOUNG HUNTERS OF MY GENERATION**, I too grew up carrying a hand-me-down lever action Model 94, except mine was chambered in .44 Remington Magnum. When the time was right, that rifle would snap up and onto my shoulder—my eye perfectly aligned behind the peep sight—as I took the slack out of the trigger; milliseconds later the rush of recoil was absorbed by my boney shoulder. I loved and respected that rifle; it was lightweight (at least during the first hour), hard-hitting and pretty handy—considering the alternatives for me at the time. Thanks to the seemingly never-ending dry practice sessions on my grandparent's front lawn, I was able to manipulate and accurately shoot that '94 at a subconscious level, just like precision casting a fly rod, the other skill honed on that very same stretch of lawn.

All my admiration for that old Winchester seemingly evaporated the first time I laid hands on an AR-style rifle. The platform's incredible ergonomics gave me an almost reassuring, yet comforting confidence, almost as if Stoner himself had designed the rifle with me in-mind. The

utilitarian to me. It was love at first sight. Now, what I quickly learned was that, while your standard AR chambered in 5.56 NATO may be ideal for bipeds, it isn't necessarily

the optimal choice for medium to larger sized game animals. For that, a little more lead is required. Which brings me yet another reason to love the AR-pattern ri-fle — caliber choices! The AR-15 is really a modern marvel and can be chambered in a multitude of calibers to fit your specific needs, even in calibers that may give you pause. Those living in certain mid-western states have a unique requirement for a straight-walled cartridge of specific dimensions, if they want to hunt deer with a centerfire rifle. In 2014, Michi-

gan's Natural Resources Commission approved a regulation to allow the use of rifles capable of using .35-caliber or larger ammunition with straight-walled cartridges that have a minimum case length of 1.16-inches and a maximum case length of 1.8-inches to harvest deer in limited firearms zones. These dimensions were instituted to reduce the likelihood of a bullet traveling far enough beyond an intended target to pose much of a threat. The law started in Michigan but spread to neighboring state Ohio and then on to Pennsylvania and Indiana. When it comes to straight-walled cartridges compatible with the AR-15, pickings are slim. But the motivation for modern hunters to find a suitable alternative to a shotgun firing slugs was high, to say the least. One such load is the .450 Bushmaster, a concept originally dreamed of by none other than

the late Col. Jeff Cooper, and made a reality by Tim LeGendre, and eventually modified by Hornady Manufacturing. Cooper had envisioned a large bore cartridge in a semi-auto rifle capable of one-shot kills on large game animals out to about 250 yards. LeGendre developed what was coined the 45 Professional cartridge, and later delivered a functional AR-

15 to Cooper in said chambering. Hornady got involved, and after some modification to case diameter and overall length, they were able to top the cartridge with their 250-grain SST Flex-Tip bullet, and thanks to a new OAL of 1.700-inches, it could be shoehorned into a slightly modified AR magazine with a single-stack follower, albeit at a significantly reduced capacity. In my mind, a modern

vantage of the NRC's reform. After this change, Bartt Brenton, found himself in a frustrating position. As a fellow lover of the AR-pattern rifle, Brenton quickly discovered his choices of straight walled cartridges were not overly broad in his preferred platform, especially in a factory configured rifle. Instead of accepting this, he saw an opportunity to not only solve the problem for himself, but for an entire region of hunters spanning multiple states. Brenton USA was born.

As a career engineer, Bartt Brenton spent his career working at the world's largest superconducting cyclotron laboratory located at Michigan State University. As a lifelong hunter, Brenton's many years afield — combined with his scientific experiences and exposure to technologically advanced science and materials — gave him an advantage over others within the space. Combining the two, Brenton be-

gan building rifles for the serious AR hunter, with an objective of providing a hunting-specific platform that took full advantage of all the benefits the AR brings to the table, but in a premium yet no-nonsense form factor. who shared his passion and desire for a slicked-up, big-bore sledgehammer of an AR in .450 Bushmaster.

The bolt-carrier group is finished in a NiB (nickel boron) UCT EXO coating. The EXO NiB coating is high in hardness, yet lower in friction than either chrome or nickel Teflon. A high-phosphorous electroless nickel base coating ensures excellent corrosion resistance not found in other nickel-boron finishes that utilize a single, thinner layer; all equating to unquestionable reliability.

The 18-inch barrel is conveniently threaded to accept your choice of muzzle device or sound suppressor, with our preference being the latter — especially when paired with subsonic 450 Bushmaster in the near 400-grain range. The barrel is encased by a 15-inch free-floating handguard constructed of reinforced carbon-fiber composite for toughness, weather resistance and for its extreme lightweight that really balances the rifle nicely. The handguard has a pair of Picatinny rail sections at either end and positioned at 6 o'clock for mounting the rifle on a tripod or utilizing a bipod.

A fixed Magpul MOE stock was chosen for its extremely consistent cheek-weld and massive internal storage capacity. The MOE stock features multiple QD sockets for attaching the rear point of a sling, however, the only choice for a front attachment is a QD cup located at the rear of the front most Picatinny rail section at 6 o'clock. All controls, including the bolt release/hold open, magazine release, charging handle, rear takedown pin have been extended and the triggerguard has been enlarged — all in an effort to increase the platform's usability with gloved hands in the cold winter months the

Midwest is known for.

The trigger is Brenton's own Performance Grade Trigger, which is a single-stage drop-in cassette style trigger. The pull weight is user adjustable from 3.5 to 6.5 pounds and the trigger shoe provides a nice contour that is not only functional but atheistically pleasing. Brenton states each trigger is hand-tuned and test-fired (at their test bench) for optimal performance by one of their expert trigger technicians as the final quality check before it's ready for delivery. Our trigger measured 3 pounds 13 ounces using a Lyman Digital Trigger Pull Gauge. Finally, our Stalker was attractively finished in a Marblekote Harvest camouflage pattern that will no doubt blend into most late season terrain. Three other

patterns are also available. Accuracy, Accuracy, Accuracy. Chambered in .450 Bushmaster, the Stalker Carbon Hunter is fully capable of ethically taking virtually any big-game critter in North America. Not only is the Stalker Carbon Hunter in .450 Bushmaster a lead-launching sledgehammer, it does so with scalpel-like precision. At 50 yards, the rifle clover-leafed three rounds of 300-grain Federal Power-Shok — the only ammunition available to us during testing. Moving out to 100 yards the rifle pounded out a three-shot group measuring just 0.58-inches. As long as the distance to target remained

reasonable, I would absolutely take this rifle/ cartridge combination in pursuit of any game in North America, with absolute confidence.

For many years, the uncasing of a magazine-fed AR-style semiautomatic rifle would draw instant sneers, regardless of its chambering, regardless of its color. The mere sight was an instant turnoff for a majority hunters whose paths we'd cross afield. Thankfully those times have changed, and while I can't speak for the hunting community as a whole, within the regions that I've been hunting these last few

definitely are NOT the Mossberg Reserve O/U shotguns of yesteryear. That's not to say that the previous generation of shotguns were terrible,

but these are certainly an upgrade. The first Silver Reserve guns to come out were a bit rough around the edges, and truth be told, we didn't





feel compelled to give them the feature-article space in the pages of On Target like we did with the current crop. The Silver Reserve line has now grown into a well-respected, good quality, entry-level O/U shotgun.

The subject of this review is the least expensive shotgun of the six Silver Reserve models-the Eventide (\$636). Basically an all-black version of the standard Silver Reserve, with an all-weather synthetic buttstock and forearm, the Eventide is mechanically identical to all only in 12-gauge, it features 28inch barrels and 3-inch chambers, making it of potentially the most interest to the greatest number of readers. That's because you can do everything a shotgun will do with this one. In addition to its

all-weather durability, shoot-anything 28-inch barrels and 3-inch chambers for magnum loads let you hunt deer, waterfowl, turkeys, upland birds, varmints and other small game; protect your family and your home; and shoot trap, skeet, 5-stand and sporting clays. If I've left out anything a shotgun can do, be assured that the Mossberg Silver Reserve Eventide will get the job done. Not surprisingly, the Eventide is

designed with a box-lock action-as opposed to a side-lock, which is becoming increasingly rare and ungodly expensive. Lock-up was rock solid, even with the forearm removed. It features a single selective trigger, with the barrel selector being internally integrated into the sliding safety selector mounted at the aft end of the abbreviated top tang, directly behind the locking lever. Our sample gun had never been fired except for proofing, so everything was quite tight. That

was most obvious with the locking lever, which took a LOT of force to push to the right to open—and it was a long push before the muzzles finally dropped. The safety/barrel selector was better, but still was no piece of cake to operate. Mercifully, however, the safety does not automatically reset to on-safe every time the action is opened (the bane of clay target shooters). The trigger exhibited a long take-up, roughly 3/8ths of an inch, to a really hard wall, with just a hint of stacking before the

break, which occurred at a consistently heavy 6.5 lbs. with either barrel. I'd call it an acceptable field trigger, but an awkward trigger for clay target shooting. The pull will undoubtedly get better with use.

The barrels are fitted with flush choke tubes, and accordingly flare out at the muzzles to provide space for the screw-in tubes. The gun comes with five choke tubes—in constrictions ranging from Full to Improved Cylinder-and includes a plastic case, choke tube wrench and a couple of Allen wrenches. The barrels feature ventilated mid and top ribs, with a red fiber-optic front sight mounted up front. The 3-inch chambers are equipped with a single gang extractor—good news for clay target shooters, less so for hunters who prefer empties to be ejected.

The buttstock and forearm are made from matte black polymer with pointy molded-in checkering that provides a good grip. The butt is fitted with a not-too-cushy rubber pad; this would probably be our one recommended upgrade for Eventide owners.

Shooting the Silver Reserve Eventide produced no unusual results. The gun balanced and swung well, and if we were doing our part, hit all of the

clays that were launched downrange. With 175 rounds through the Mossberg as of writing this — both in good and bad weather — the gun has done everything we've asked of it without hiccup, which is exactly what the end user of a shotgun like the Eventide is going to expect.

Overall, for the money, you'd be hard pressed to find a better quality, more versatile O/U shotgun for hunting or clay target shooting. See the Silver Reserve Eventide at your gun shop, or for more information contact 0. F. MOSSBERG & SONS, Tel.: (203) 230-5300; Web: WWW.MOSSBERG.COM
